The children will dive into an adventure story in literacy, followed by an information text all about astronauts. In maths, we are going to focus on Place Value initially before moving on to Addition and Subtraction in Autumn 2. We will look at Van Gogh's 'Starry night' during art and recreate the famous piece using different mediums within art, before finally finishing off our project by recreating a digital explanation of the planets, which we will share with another class.
