Talk to your grown up about the 'people who help us' pictures on seesaw. Discuss each person and how they help us in the community.	Find a squiggle it episode on YouTube that you like, draw with Squiggle it.	Pick your favourite Go Noodle and have a dance!
Can your grown up hide some of your key words around the house. Go on a key word hunt!	Can you use your cubes to explore number bonds to 10? Write your calculations on your board as you go. (I will upload a video example on seesaw)	Learn your address and what you would do or say if you had to call 999 in an emergency.	Play "I Spy" with your grown up.	Bake your favourite treat today with your grown up.
Please read one of your Phonics books with your grown up.	Use the number fan in your maths bag. Your grown can ask you to show them what is "one more than" and to show what is "one less than" Eg "show me the number that is one more than 5 (child would have to hold up 6) same with less than.	Create your own emergency vehicle. This about its Features- sirens/bright colours/ladders/hose pipes. Use junk modelling in your home or draw it as a picture.
